## 2025 – 15% return allowed of Show & Deliver Product

Per the Unit Chair training, only 15% of your entire physical S&D product checked out as of Nov 7 can be returned at one of the return sites.

# How to find your final product inventory to calculate the 15%

1. Log into the Trail's End Leader Portal

2. Scroll down to the PRODUCTS section. The total at the bottom of the "ORDERED AMT" column is

how much you have checked out in retail dollars.

# How to calculate your returns

Find your retail total of ALL of your product you have checked out as of Nov 7.

- Retail total is your initial order plus or minus any addons, transfers, and returns. Simply, it is the amount of <a href="mailto:physical">physical</a> product your unit is responsible for at the end of the sale.
- Take 15% of that retail total. That is what your unit can return. It can be a mix of anything you have.
- Example-


0	Initial order	+\$10,000
0	Transfer TO Pack 9123	- \$ 500
0	Transfer FROM Pack 3456	+\$1,000
0	Early returns	-\$2,000
0	TOTAL PRODUCT	\$8,500

- $\circ$  .15 x \$8,500 = \$1275
- o Unit can return up to \$1275 in product.

If your sales are entered in Trail's End, you can also see how much you have remaining in dollars by clicking the Dollars button under Products:



#### **Notes**

- Make sure you have accepted all transfers (if you have any)
- Final return % does NOT include any online direct purchases, as they are direct from Trail's End.
- Final return % does NOT include any Hometown Heroes donations, as they are not checked out physical retail product.
- You can continue to transfer product to other units that need it after Nov 7, but the return sites will have a list showing the amount you have checked out as of Nov 7 to use as a 15% guideline.
- You can <u>NOT</u> fill your Heroes and Helpers/Hometown Heroes with your unit's leftover product. See HH information in the End of Sale Guide.
- Product over the 15% threshold will be kept by the unit and can be sold by the unit after the official end of sale.
- Scouts can still sell product as long as you have it. Schedule storefronts or do neighborhood blitzes Nov 3-Nov 9 and beyond if you have extra inventory.
- If you are over the 15% return rate, you cannot trade leftover product for other product. Keep what you want to sell.
- You can pick up product you need at the sites as long as it was returned by a different unit.

## **Return Instructions:**

- 1. <u>Use Leftover Show & Deliver Product to fill your Take Orders</u>—Fill your take orders with leftover Show and Deliver Product. **DO NOT FILL HOMETOWN HEROES** with product. Those are automatically ordered as Heroes and Helpers through the Trail's End system.
- 2. You can return full cases AND singles. Please only put the same product in the product boxes. All products can be returned in opened cases. You cannot return any product that has stickers, rips, tears, or a melted brick of pretzels. If it was damaged when you received it, please report it on <a href="https://www.buyscoutpopcorn.com">www.buyscoutpopcorn.com</a> in the Kernal section.
- 3. <u>Bring leftover Show & Deliver product to a Return Center</u>—Check the sites on the next page for the site nearest you. <u>Please help us continue to not charge units a restocking fee by following these Return instructions.</u>
- **4.** You will be able to pick up any product you need <u>if</u> it is available at the site.
- **5.** Returns will ONLY be accepted at one of the return centers at the dates and times listed. Please plan accordingly. If you cannot be there, arrange for another member of your unit to return it.
- 6. We will NOT take returns after the dates posted in this guide.
